BENEFITS OF SPONSORSHIP

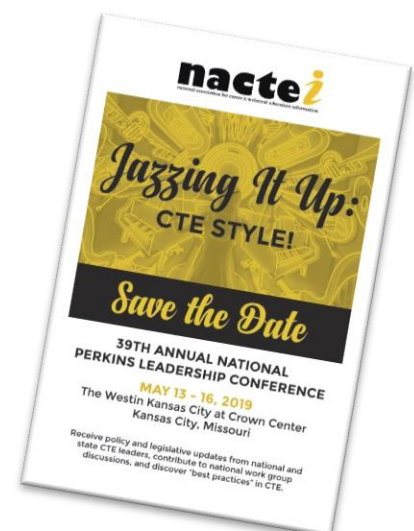
